

**Call for papers: PhD workshop on energy economics  
of the AEE student chapter  
15 February 2011 – Vienna University of Technology**

The Austrian Association for Energy Economics (AEE) together with the Energy Economics Group (EEG) of Vienna University of Technology will host a PhD-students workshop on energy economics accompanying the 7<sup>th</sup> *Internationale Energiewirtschaftstagung (IEWT 2011, 16 to 18 February 2011)*.

The main objective is to provide a platform for presentations and in-depth discussions of research of PhD students in the field of energy economics. The workshop shall deepen the exchange among PhD students and between junior and senior scientists. The objective of this workshop is not to replace student participation at the 7<sup>th</sup> *Internationale Energiewirtschaftstagung*! The organisers of the 7<sup>th</sup> *Internationale Energiewirtschaftstagung* encourage students to submit abstracts for their separate meeting.<sup>1</sup>

The schedule of the PhD workshop aims to allow for increased available discussion time for each paper compared to regular conferences. All student participants of the 7<sup>th</sup> *Internationale Energiewirtschaftstagung* will be invited to attend the PhD workshop and efforts will be made to bring in senior researchers and practitioners.

The topics for the presentations can be of theoretical or empirical nature and can, among others, address the following aspects:

- Price formation in energy markets: Impact parameters and investments
- Electricity grids of the future: Technological and economic assessments
- Integration of renewable energies in electricity networks: Technical and economic analysis
- Efficient use of final energy in buildings, transport and industry
- Long term scenarios of the energy supply sector, energy usage and associated costs
- Assessment of energy policy measures
- Modelling aspects of market and system analyses
- International cooperation and development

The workshop language will be English. (Please note that the conference language of the *IEWT* will be German.)

#### **Submission of abstracts**

Please send an abstract (comprising (1) overview, (2) methods, (3) results, and (4) conclusions) of your work (about 2 pages in English) **until 15 December 2010** as pdf or word file to: [redl@eeg.tuwien.ac.at](mailto:redl@eeg.tuwien.ac.at). You will be informed by 23 December 2011 about the acceptance of your contribution.

#### **Participation**

The workshop will take place on 15 February 2011 at Vienna University of Technology. The participation at the workshop includes coffee breaks and is free of charge. Registration is required by 31 January 2011 (see below).
