The Spanish Association for Energy Economics (AEEE) announces its sixth conference for January 20th and 21st, 2011 at the Casa de Convalecencia in Barcelona.

AEEE is the Spanish section of the International Association for Energy Economics (IAEE) and promotes, among other activities, the organization of an annual Conference dealing with the economics of the energy sector.

In its sixth edition, the AEEE conference is trying to strengthen ties with universities, regulators and the companies. To this extent and complementing the academic sessions (subject to call for papers and, this time, with specific discussants assigned), an invited academic session and a round table with participation of researchers, business representatives and regulators are scheduled.

> Paper submission

We invite all researchers to send their theoretical and empirical papers, before November 14th, for their presentation at the Parallel sessions at the conference. Papers can be submitted in English or Spanish. They should be sent as a single PDF file with a maximum size of 2MB, to the following e-mail address: aeee@aeee.es. The following information should be included: Name of authors, Affiliation, and email addresses of the authors and co-authors; Title of paper, Abstract (no more than 100 words); JEL codes; and a maximum of 5 keywords. The papers will be subject to an evaluation by the Scientific Committee.

December 15th: Notification of acceptance of papers
From December 16th, 2009: Registration opens

> **Work dissemination**

Attendants will be provided with the papers presented in electronic format. Papers will be also available, only for members, in the Association website. Authors who submit papers in attendance to this call agree with the above conditions of dissemination.

> **Logistics**

The website of the association (www.aeee.es) will provide updates on the conference, with information on accommodation, venue and the final program.

> **Registration and fees**

At least one author for each accepted paper must pay the registration fee and attend the conference to present the paper. The fee entitles to dinner, lunches, coffees and documentation.

> **Academic awards: Young AEEE Researcher 2011**

A prize will be awarded to the best paper by a young researcher (under 35 years old) in the parallel sessions. Applicants for this distinction must state explicitly that they intend to opt for this award. Being the only author of the paper will be considered in a positive way. In other case, she will be the corresponding author and the one doing the presentation of the paper. The Scientific Committee will be responsible for the decision (including leaving the prize unawarded). The winner will receive a certificate, a gift and a refund of the registration fee.
