Aim of the Workshop

The aim of the workshop is to give PhD and master students in energy economics the opportunity to present their work, i.e. “work in progress”, master theses or dissertations. Furthermore, the collaboration with the French student chapter allows the knowledge exchange and interaction on European level.

The topics for the presentations can be of theoretical or empirical nature and can, among others, address the following aspects:

I. Cross-sector aspects:

- Regulation and liberalization of network industries
- New corporate strategies in changed business environment (sustainability thinking)
- Risk management in energy trading
- Smart grid economics

II. Analysis of sector-specific aspects and case studies:

- Energy markets (electricity, natural gas, oil, coal, etc.)
- Renewable energies (potentials, technology, economic aspects)
- Global warming economics and emission trading

III. Innovative technologies economics:

- Hydrogen economy (production, distribution, economic viability, etc.)
- Plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEV)
- Innovations in energy technology (power plants, etc.)
