



“Assistant or Associate Professor in Strategy and Innovation in the Energy Sector”

*Grenoble Ecole de Management invites applications for a full-time position in **strategy and innovation** at the assistant or associate professor level with a research and teaching focus on the energy sector (starting date September 2013).*

Grenoble Ecole de Management (www.grenoble-em.com) is a fast growing business school located at the foot of the French Alps in a vibrant and growing metropolitan area with a strong emphasis on high-tech industries (e.g. energy, nanotechnologies, and microelectronics). Candidates should also demonstrate their ability to teach successfully for various levels and audiences and their willingness to be involved in the institution. A specific requirement for this position is the ability to reach out to business in the form of training courses, workshops and (applied) research. A good working knowledge of the French language would be a strong asset, but not a requirement.
